The three woes were announced in Revelation 8:13. The fifth trumpet plague was the first woe, the sixth trumpet plague of 9:12 was the second woe. Mention of the third woe heightens the expectation that the end is coming “very soon” (11:14).

As I watched, I heard an eagle that was flying in midair call out in a loud voice: “Woe! Woe! Woe to the inhabitants of the earth, because of the trumpet blasts about to be sounded by the other three angels!”
